Operations manager

The successful applicant will have an understanding of Accounting procedures, managing multi-site venue booking, organise teams and users visiting the region and maintain membership records. Applicants should have excellent time management skills, experience in team sport management, media skills and knowledge as well as an RSA NSW/Vic. Remuneration will be based on the Sporting Organisations Award and be part time subject to the demands of the Hockey season.

Capital League Coaches

A payment for the Coaches will be agreed subject to agreed performance benchmarks.

Sports conditioning and assessment services
