The first newsletter of the year is designed to give you the information you need ahead of what's expected to be another great year for Norths Hockey.

## 2019 TEAM NOMINATIONS

Norths have entered 7 senior teams, which adds up to a team in each of the Men's and Women's divisions as well as a Women's Masters team.

In the Junior ranks, we have entered 2 Mixed Under 10s teams, Under 12 and Under 14 Girls teams and Under 12s, Under 14s and Under 16s Boys.

We will be doing our best to ensure each of these teams has strong numbers and any help you might be able to give us with finding/recruiting players will be much appreciated.

## 2019 COACH NOMINATIONS

Nominations for coaches for all Norths teams close Wednesday, January 23, 2019 at 5pm.

Requirements for coaches are as follows:

- Must be Hockey Victoria registered (even if non-playing)
- It is compulsory to have a Working with Children Check and have completed Community Coaching and be working towards Level 1 Coaching by the end of the year. This is a HAW requirement.
- To commit to attending 80% of training sessions and matches and to ensure an assistant can cover if not available.
- To communicate and work with all other coaches, teams and committee members. Joint coaches work well, especially with our Junior teams.

## HOCKEY VICTORIA REGISTRATION

HV registration for 2019 is now open.

All players must be registered before taking to the field.

All committee members, non-playing coaches and managers will also need to complete HV

registration. (This is for insurance cover, however there is no fee).
